Effectively seconded by his brother, AN21, and the outstanding Max Vangeli, Steve Angello offers an out-of-the-ordinary experience to the rhythms of his own striking blend of **progressive house and electro**, made to measure for big rooms.

The ascent of Steve Angello

Since the success of his celebrated remixes of the classics "**Sweet Dreams**" and "**Small Town Boy (Tell Me Why)**" in the mid-2000s, Steve Angello has kept on climbing the ladder until today he ranks among the most influential producers and DJs on planet house. A member of the informal collective **Swedish House Mafia** alongside **Axwell** and **Sebastian Ingrosso**, he's also made a name for himself through his many collaborations with **Eric Prydz**. At the helm of the Size Records label, which over the years has become a veritable hit factory, Angello lords it over dancefloors with productions of his own like "**Sexy Fuck**," "**KNAS**" and mega-hits like "**Be**" and "**Show Me Your Love (feat. Robin S)**," both of these done in collaboration with **Laidback Luke**. And the recent "**Open Your Eyes**," co-signed by **Alex Metric** with the participation of singer **Ian Brown** (Stone Roses), undeniably adds another powerful string to his bow. Sought-after in the four corners of the globe, Steve Angello continues his well-named *Size Matters* tour, where he'll be piling up incendiary sets sparked by tech, progressive and electro rhythms delivered foot to the floor.
